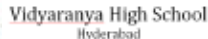





World Music Day is a connected set of free music events which takes place each year on the 21st June. This "festival of music" is no ordinary festival. Created in France in 1982, it has been taken up by over 120 countries where it has been just as successful. Music takes over the city's streets, with live bands, singers, amateur musicians, drummers, DJs and so on scattered throughout the city, expressing themselves through music and inviting the crowd to enjoy themselves.

Hyderabad has been a contributor towards this festival for several years. It has grown from being a small event at Alliance Française to becoming a big music festival (~ 2000 spectators in 2016) in the city, bringing together musicians from India and abroad and reflecting the whole palette of music styles and genres: Indian modern and traditional, western classical, rock or fusion. Since 2016, the festival takes yet another leap forward, in an attempt to get closer to the real "French World Music Day" concept. Thus, shifting from a one stage, one crowd, centralized, concert style to several venues across the city.

Cécile Loyer



In this contemporary dance project, the French artist Cécile Loyer weaves together the stories and the histories of dance.

"Histoires Vraies" is, first and foremost, an enquiry into the origins of movement and how movements are passed on. Having been introduced to bharathanatyam, Cécile Loyer creates a mix contrasting two different traditions and their use of the body. On the stage, 2 Indian dancers and 2 European dancers turn themselves into witnesses and narrators of their own stories. This bizarre, often funny, chaos of gestures narrates our 'collective history' and tries to capture the essence of what dance is and to see whether movements, gestures and signs can help us discover other versions of history – less tangible but more moving ?

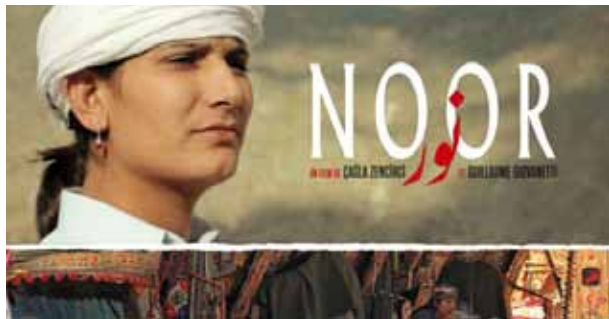

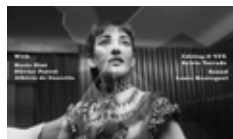

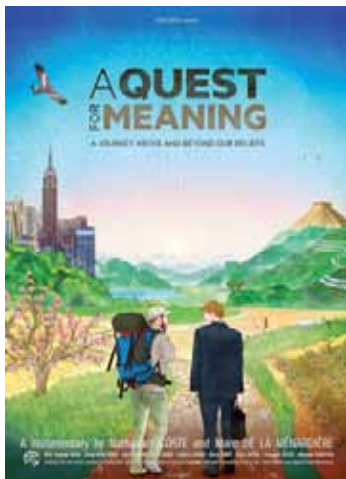

Water cooperation:

From June 6 to 8, Mr Prashant Reddy, M.L.A. Vice-chairman Mission Bhagiratha, Government of Telangana will be visiting Bordeaux, along with his staff. This visit will allow him to discover Bordeaux water supply and management system, in order for Bordeaux to initiate a project to support Mission Bhagiratha, through capacity building and trainings.



From June 20 to 24, a delegation from Bordeaux will be present in Hyderabad, to attend a workshop organized by Saci Waters, organization which conducted a two-year research project on peri-urban water security, co-funded by Bordeaux Métropole.

Participation of Hyderabad in Agora 2017: architecture, urbanism and design biennale of Bordeaux.

The seventh edition of Agora, dedicated to the theme of landscape, will be held from September 14th to 24th in Bordeaux. To enrich the debates and share experiences, Agora collaborates with Bordeaux international partner cities, and among them Hyderabad. Therefore, Hyderabad city and its great landscape will be represented in Agora, at different venues and through different medium: photography exhibition by the Kalakriti art gallery, photography exhibition on Hyderabad with the help of many local photographers, open-air screening of documentary and fiction films, model of the city, international debates... An official delegation from Telangana will be present for the occasion.

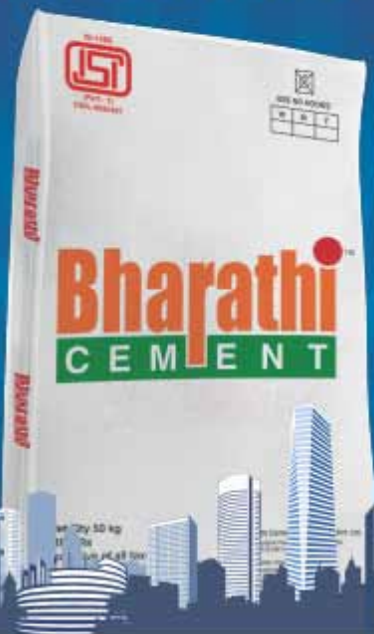
