Raphaëlle is a French who has been living in Hyderabad since January 2014. She started Clarinet studies back in 1996, when she was 8 years old, in the Conservatoire National de Région de Nantes. She took classes with concert clarinetist Yves Sévère for 6 years. After moving to Versailles in 2004, she discovered ensemble music & Jazz. She joined the Orchestre Philharmonique de Paris et de L'Ouest Francilien (a symphonic orchestra, uniting advanced amateurs and professional musicians to play pieces from composers such as Prokofiev, Medelsohn, Dvorak and others). She also joined the Jazzmen du Colombier, a Dixieland orchestra based in Yvelines in 2004. She has played with different amateur ensemble in Lyon, Yvelines region and India with a repertoire ranging from classical to movie soundtracks, European popular music and jazz.

Astrid N. Muller was born in South Germany. She started playing violin at the age of 5, as well as singing two years later. She enrolled in a youth university program, followed by studies in Berlin and the US and is since then concertizing as singer and instrumentalist in duo with piano, in chamber-music-groups and orchestras. There she had the opportunity to work with renowned musicians like Menahem Pressler, Claudio Abbado and Vladimir Ashkenazy. As a teacher Astrid N.Müller has experience of over a decade of teaching violin/viola at the University School of Music, Hamburg. Her training as a body therapist influences the voice training and instrumental teaching.
