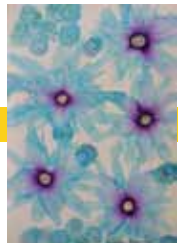
BLOOMS//EVOLUTION

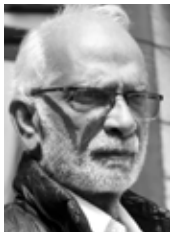

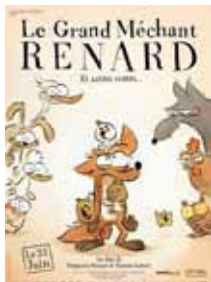
